

Seventh Annual Fultondale Barking at the Moon Festival 2018

Join us for The Seventh Annual Barking at the Moon Festival hosted by the City of Fultondale and Friends of the Fultondale Bark Park. The event is Sunday, October 28th, 2018 from 1-6 pm at the Fultondale Bark Park/Children's Park. The Fultondale Bark Park, is located at 2398 Stouts Rd. in Fultondale, Al, at the intersection of Stouts and Fulton Roads- behind the Children's Park. The Children's Park also will be used for vendor set up.

Proceeds from the festival will be used by the Friends of the Fultondale Bark Park and the City of Fultondale to upgrade and make improvements to the dog park.

Vendor spaces will be assigned by number and by the Friends of the Fultondale Bark Park Committee; Sponsor booths will be assigned before vendor spaces. Food vendors will have designated areas near power sources.

VENDOR PACKAGES

The following vendor packages are offered based on your designation as for-profit or nonprofit. Nonprofit or educational vendors must provide proof of your 501 C (3) designation.

Electricity	\$25 extra

If you need a larger space, you must buy 2 10x10s.

- **Please register by October 19th.** If you cannot participate for any reason we understand, but **no refunds will be given. Event is rain or shine.**

- All booths must be set up between 8:30 am -12pm on October 28th. Breakdown will be immediately at the end of the event. No early breakdown is allowed- vendors must commit to the entire time of the event. You may drive in to unload and load. **Vehicles must be moved by 12:30pm.**
- Food vendors must have appropriate business and/or Health Department licenses on-hand at the event. We will apply for a temporary food permit from Jefferson County.
- **Food vendors selling soft drink and beverages must serve CocaCola products, including Dasani Water. No exceptions.**
- **Food Vendors must indicate what you will be selling and cannot change your menu without approval from the committee. We will try to have no competing food vendors, but cannot guarantee there won't be. When you register, you will be notified if your menu is approved. Registration is first come, first serve.**
- Vendors are responsible for staffing, set-up and break down of their booths and must bring own change funds. Vendors must staff their own booths at all times and provide own tent, tables and chairs.
- You must have a copy of business license available for viewing if asked to show it.
- Neither the names **Barking at the Moon Festival** nor **Fultondale Bark Park** can be used without authorization. Friends of the Fultondale Bark Park reserve the right to sell official Barking at the Moon merchandise.
- Vendors are responsible for paying all taxes (sales, use and other applicable taxes).
- Neither Friends of the Fultondale Bark Park, the City of Fultondale or the Children's Park are responsible for any lost, stolen or damaged property during the Barking at the Moon Festival.
